Dear Franklin Families -

We are so excited to work with you and your students in the coming school year! When students have all of their supplies ready for the beginning of school, we are able to jump into deeper learning from day one. Please note that your students may or may not be in all of the classes listed for each grade level. ***To be announced** (to be determined) indicates this is a new faculty member who has not yet listed supplies. S/he will let students know of any supplies needed for that course on the first day of class. Elective Classes - many elective classes' supplies are listed below, while in some classes, students will find out what classroom supplies they need, the first week of school.

There is a one-time \$35.00 consumables fee, which covers things like expedition materials, science labs, supplemental reading books, workbooks and other instructional consumable materials. The school will send out invoices for the consumables fee through email at the beginning of the school year which can be paid online or by cash or check.

Field trips generally require additional fees, but with the uncertainty of this year, we will provide specific information on those opportunities when/if we are able to schedule them. If these take place the school will again send out invoices via email which can be paid online or with cash or check.
