 - Enrollment is slightly down but not out of ordinary; still funded for 748 students
 - Slight increase in chronic absences (10% or higher absenteeism)
 - Activities
 - Received 11k staff wellness grant
 - Holiday concert Friday, Dec 12
 - Middle School Student Council Kindness Week January 12-16
- Credentialing application
- ATSI List (Additional Targeted Support and Improvement)
