### Attendance

Did you know...

- Missing just 2 days/month = chronic absenteeism
- Students who miss 2- 4 days during the 1st month of school are at high risk for chronic absenteeism
- Chronic absenteeism in middle school is a leading indicator of drop out risk
- Improving attendance is one of the most effective ways to improve student achievement.

## Good Attendance = School Success

- Students are required to attend school every day unless they have an excused absence
- Email attendance notes within 48 hours of absence: <u>attendance@thefsi.us</u>
- Doctor's note is required for absences of 5 or more days
- HS Attendance Makeup Sessions will be scheduled quarterly for students who miss 5 or more days
- Students with 20 or more absences will be considered for retention
- We will partner with you to overcome attendance issues!

#### **Specific Expectations**


- Be on time and present for all classes

- Parents/guardians are required to attend re-entry conference following suspension


## School Safety






## Upper Floor - High School
